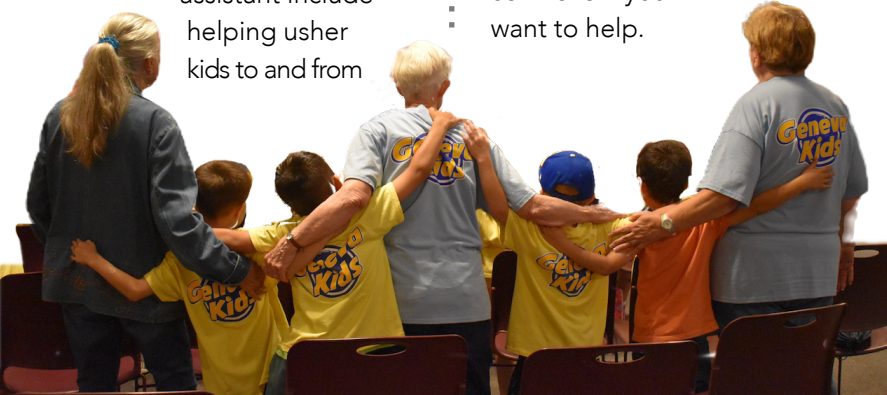
DRIVE & DROP FOOD DRIVE
